


2016-17 AIS Procedures

In July 2016, the Board of Regents approved an <u>amendment</u> to the regulation regarding the methodology by which schools identify students to receive Academic Intervention Services (AIS) based on performance on the grade 3-8 English language arts (ELA) or mathematics state assessments. The amendment changes the requirement for districts to provide AIS to all students scoring below a scale score specific to each grade and subject, and instead requires that districts identify students to receive AIS through a two-step process. According to the amended regulations, all students performing below the identified scale score **shall be <u>considered</u> for AIS** through a district-developed procedure applied uniformly at each grade level to determine which students under consideration will actually receive AIS. Ithaca's district-developed procedure to be applied uniformly at each grade-level is as follows:



If a student is determined to need AIS, the school will use a Response to Intervention (RtI) approach to deliver AIS. To learn more about Ithaca's RtI approach please review <u>Board Policy</u> 4321. 2-R and the <u>Ithaca City</u> School District Response to Intervention Procedural Manual.

Students scoring below the following scale scores will be considered for AIS for the 2016-17 school year:
