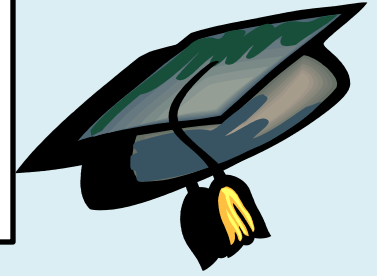


# Ithaca High School Graduation Requirements



## Credit Requirements

A minimum of 22 units of credit are required for graduation. Typically, a course which meets one period a day, five days a week, for a full school year receives one credit. Students accumulate credits toward graduation while fulfilling core requirements. Any additional credits needed to complete the 22 credits for graduation may be met with elective courses.

**English:** 4

**Social Studies:** 4

**Math:** 3

**Science:** 3

**World Language:** 1

(3 for an Advanced Designation endorsement)

A 5-unit sequence in Technology & Engineering Education or Fine Arts will exempt from second or third world language course)

**Fine Art:** 1

**Health:** ½

**Physical Education:** 2



## Assessment & Diplomas

Regents Assessment requirements are intended to assure that high school graduates have met the New York State Learning Standards in English, Social Studies, Math and Science. An additional assessment may be required in World Languages. To earn a NY State High School Diploma, a student must pass Regents assessments with a score of 65 (or NYS Ed. Approved Alternatives) in the following areas:
