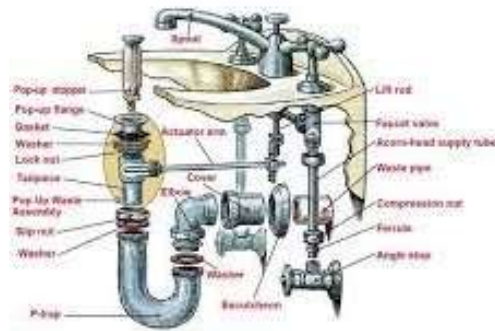


# Definition of Terms:

# Action Plan for Caroline and Enfield

## Replacement of Faucets, Shut-offs, and Feedlines

- » All classrooms, nurses offices, kitchens and faculty rooms
- » Approximate cost of supplies and equipment is \$15,000

## Five ICSD Maintainers will work for the next six weeks to remove and replace approximately 100 fixtures


- » Work will take place some evenings and most weekends.





## **Action Plan for Caroline and Enfield**

**Testing of new outlets will occur after the replacement and will be sent to Microbac**

- » Testing results will be posted to the ICSD website and uploaded to Department of Health.
  - » For outlets with test results below the action level of 15 ppb, “Hand-Washing Only” signs will be removed.
  - » For outlets with test results at or above the action level of 15 ppb, signage will remain in place and further remediation strategies will be determined.
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## **Action Plan for other ICSD Schools**

### **Replacement of Faucets, Shut-offs, and Feedlines**

- » Northeast and South Hill (December - February)
- » Cayuga Heights and Belle Sherman  
(March - June)
- » All other buildings post July 2018

### **Pilot one Bottle Filler / Fountain Combination at both BJM and Belle Sherman Annex**

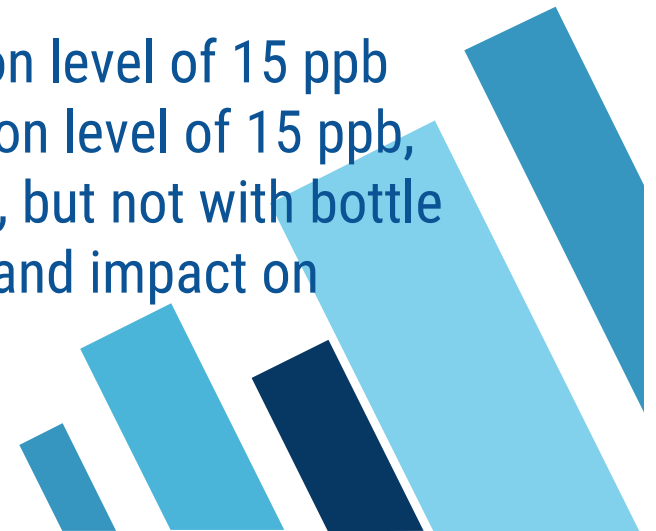
- » Granted by Tompkins County Health Department (TCHD)
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## **Action Plan for other ICSD Schools**

### **Filtered Bottle Filler / Fountain Combination Installation throughout the District**

- » Upon approval and implementation of TCHD guidance document for all Tompkins County Schools
- » Only for outlets that have tested below the action level of 15 ppb
- » For outlets with test results at or above the action level of 15 ppb, replacement of water fountains are encouraged, but not with bottle filler / bubbler combos due to filtration system and impact on testing



## **Other Items:**

- Monthly meetings with Tompkins County Health Dept
- Draft report from LaBella being finalized
- Communication to ICSD Community
- Funding of remediation efforts
- Plan for decreasing dependence on certified water coolers throughout ICSD
